In compliance with the previous legislation referred to, the data will be processed according to honesty principles, lawfulness and transparency for the protection of your privacy and rights.

- 1. Object of treatment The Data Controller processes personal data (and not the sensitive information) such as name, surname, VAT number, email address, telephone number, curriculum vitae afterwards, "Personal data" or even "data") communicated when applying for the invitation to tender.
- 2.
